

# Admission Policy for the Faculty of Medicine (International Program) King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang (KMITL) 2019 Academic Year (Direct Admission)

**Opening Seats:** 50 students

**Standard Qualifications:**

1. Academic achievement: the applicant must complete or study in the final year of the following educational systems:
  - a. Mathayom 6 or equivalent in regular Thai program
  - b. Grade 12 in the US program
  - c. Year 13 in the UK program
  
2. Standard academic test, one of the following:
  - a. SAT Subject Test (SAT II) including (1) Biology (2) Chemistry (3) Physics or Mathematics.
  - b. BioMedical Admissions Test (BMAT)
  
3. English proficiency test, one of the following:
  - a. TOEFL (Paper-based Test) not less than 580 or
  - b. TOEFL (Internet-based Test) not less than 100 or
  - c. IELTS (Academic-Module) not less than 7
  
4. We also require the applicant to attach a **'personal statement'** describing the motivation for studying medicine in our program as well as their expectations for their academic career. The length should not exceed 1000 words.

**Remark:** For non-Thai students, the graduates are not allowed to take examinations for Thai medical license.
